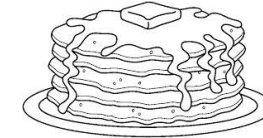

Volunteer to share a talent or skill with the congregation at large! Have a hobby? Want to start up a game or family movie night? The opportunities are endless!

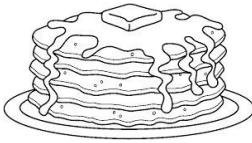

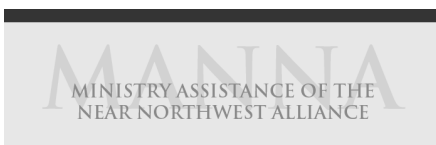
