Pastor Lataya's sermon on Amazing Grace reminded me once again how much our kids are listening to us, even when it seems like they are not paying attention. Lyra (Alves) sat beside me in the pew, quietly coloring a picture when Pastor Lataya recited the first line of the hymn: "Amazing Grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me." Lyra immediately stopped what she was doing to look up at me and quietly (but excitedly) say, "Gigi, it's that song you sing to Harper!"
